Elisabeth Max-Theurer welcomes everybody, opens the meeting.

The minutes of the last meeting (19.06.2017 Brno) were approved. As follow up Frank Spadinger asked Anikó Losonczy if she could approach Mrs Braun concerning the CED Logo rights.

It was decided that the calendar will be one sided. The format and the produced number were discussed. Mrs Elisabeth Max Theurer sent a link to Daniel Karpiński for the photos of the CDI Achleiten.

The National Federations of each member of the CED Working Group have confirmed their participation.

Andrzej Salacki (POL) is elected as Vice President of the Central European Dressage Working Group (CED).

The Working Group discussed the proposal of the FEI to introduce the HiLo Drop score and came to a common conclusion. Furthermore, the new Olympic Qualification process, the FEI Dressage rules and the World Cup were discussed (all documents are attached to the protocol).

The EEJ judge course Zakrzow was discussed and agreed to send it after it is published to the members for further distribution.

The Working Group agreed that it would make more sense to have in future following Championships:

- Pony/Children/Juniors
- YR/U25/Seniors

At Senior Championship, each rider should have the possibility to compete at least two times. A consolation test or a second horse could be the solution.

The Pony Championship Dressage should be organized with the age categories Children and Juniors and no longer with the other disciplines.

In future we should put all our effort in having the World Equestrian Games in Europe because overseas is for most countries not affordable.

The next meeting will be in Zakrzo (POL). It will be during the CDI from the 26th to 29th October 2017.
